LLBN dedicates new TV studios

Loma Linda Broadcasting Network held an outdoor dedication service of the newly completed studios just east of Loma Linda on July 8 at 7 p.m. The hour-long program also marked the network's 10-year celebration of service.

At the end of the program, the building was opened for the public to view the inside.

The new studios were constructed through all volunteer labor, which matches closely with the network's all volunteer staff. LLBN focuses on programming that encourages healthy lifestyles and the spiritual component of living.

Network started in 1997 with a few hours a day of television programming. Today, LLBN reaches all of North and South America 24/7 via satellite, and is rapidly expanding.

In August, LLBN's programming will travel by optical fiber across the Atlantic Ocean to Israel where it will be uplinked to satellite Thaicom-3 covering the continents of Europe, Africa, Asia, and Australia. Once LLBN launches on this satellite, it will reach every inhabited continent on the globe. Over 90 percent of the Earth's population will be covered by LLBN's satellite signal.
