WORK STARTED ON NEW BROADCAST COMPLEX

After years of planning, fund-raising, and anticipation, LLBN broke ground in Loma Linda this spring on an expansion of its broadcast facility. The new 9,224 square-foot building, called the Great Commission Broadcast Complex, will be located next to the original 3,200 square-foot studio building.

The combined structure of 12,424 sq. ft. will warehouse all the space necessary to store and transmit high-quality Christian TV programming through optical fiber cable and satellite over LLBN's eight multilingual channels. This is essential in supporting LLBN's commitment to use the highly persuasive medium of television to spread Christ's last-day message to the world.

After the concrete flooring cured, the next steps began quickly. Steel side beams were erected and the roof steel put in place. The building's skeleton form can be seen progressing daily.

Meanwhile, the original Studio 1 next door has been fully remodeled with a new on-air performance area, redesigned audio/video control rooms and related broadcast equipment installed and tested.

As part of its fund-raising effort to finish this project, LLBN is asking viewers for their partnership by contributing \$150 for a square foot of space. All donors, regardless of amount given, will be listed on a donor wall in the new building.

KOREAN CHANNEL HOSTS CAMP MEETING



LLBN's Korean Channel held its annual camp meeting broadcast sessions in Studio 3 on July 27-29. However, because of the ongoing remodeling of Studio 1, it was held this year in the smaller LLBN studio. According to those in charge, the camp meeting's broadcast went well.

STUDIO 1 UNDERGOES RENOVATION

While construction was underway on the new building, LLBN's main Studio 1 was also undergoing change. Shut down on June 29 for 13 weeks of substantial remodeling, the studio upgrades are now complete. The first live production was held on Oct. 9-10.

The project was a major overhaul. Audio, video, lighting, and electrical components all needed to be changed or upgraded. Production equipment was reconfigured, new furniture installed, and walls painted. Video and audio control rooms were also remodeled. Studio 1's stage is now along the north wall, rather than in the structure's center.

While all this was going on, program production was shifted to Studio 3, which is roughly one quarter the size of Studio 1. Undaunted, performers, speakers, and production crews were able to offer the popular and *live* Friday evening "LLBN Worship" program in that venue.


